Coronavirus Relief Legislation

- Coronavirus Aid, Relief, Economic Security (CARES) Act
 - Effective March 2020
 - \$2.86 million – City allocation from State of Ohio
 - Money needed to be spent by end of 2020
 - \$345,135 – Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)
 - Effective March 2021
 - \$6.8 million

- Total Allocation - \$345,135
- 80% required to be spent by June 2023
- 100% required to be spent by June 2026

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

- \$6.8 million – total city allocation
 - First payment received June 2021
 - Second payment – June 2022
 - Funds need to be spent by 12/31 of 2024
- Four categories of approved uses:
 - Replacement of lost public sector revenue
 - Water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure (includes storm sewer)
 - Premium pay for low-income and front-line workers
 - COVID-19 public health and economic impacts
