The City of Fairborn invites you to participate through an online virtual public input request to review the proposed alternative for improvements to Broad Street from Dayton Drive to Pierce Drive. The project includes a reduction in lanes from 4-lanes to 3-lanes to provide room for the addition of bike lanes. Additional improvements to the intersecting roadways throughout the corridor including strategies to consolidate access points along the corridor to improve safety for motorist, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

The exact impacts to the adjacent properties are not know but it is anticipated that temporary access to facility construction will be needed on most properties abutting the work area. One-lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Broad Street, side streets may require closure for construction, exact closures and detour routes are not known at this time.

Public input is being solicited virtually with all materials posted on the website which include exhibits, handouts, and comment forms. Comment forms and project handouts can be mailed out if requested by contacting Lee Harris. Please ensure all comments are returned to Lee Harris by mail or email by **July 26, 2020**.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, or disability.
