

## REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

### City of Fairborn Notice of Proposed Substantial Amendment to HUD Consolidated Plan and Action Plan Fiscal Year 2020

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fairborn Development Services Department proposed to amend its U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Consolidated and Action Plan for 2020 to reprogram its Community Development Block Grant funds. This Notice is to allow citizens to review the activities and year of funding for these activities.

In accordance with Consolidated Plan requirements at 24 CFR Part 91 Subpart B and the City's Citizen Participation Plan, Development Services has posted the changes to the Action Plan through this reprogramming Amendment in order to provide opportunity for public comment.
