

Special Regulations

Those using the amphitheater must adhere to the noise ordinance and park hours. Shelter reservations are available online through the City website, www.ci.fairborn.oh.us.

Reservations for courts/fields must be made by calling the Fairborn Parks office at 937.754.3090.

Specific rules apply to the Spray Ground, Skate Park and Oakes Quarry Park. These rules are posted at the parks.

FAIRBORN CITY PARKS

The City of Fairborn has a special commitment to recreational areas maintaining 774 acres of land consisting of 22 parks, 548 acres of conservation areas and 7+ miles of paved bike and trail pathways. These areas are intended for the recreation and enjoyment of our residents and guests. Park patrons are expected to refrain from behavior that affects the safety, peace, and good order of the parks and park visitors. The parks are open daily from sunrise to dusk. The grounds and parking lots must be vacated at closing.



Our Parks Include:

- Sixteen Shelters
- Central Park Spray Ground
- The Atherton Amphitheater
- Osborn Skate Park
- Nine Softball Diamonds (2 lighted)
- Nine Basketball Courts (4 lighted)
- Eight Tennis Courts (4 lighted)
- Eleven Soccer Fields
- Three Fishing Areas
- Two Lighted Baseball Diamonds
- Two Sand Volleyball Courts
- Seventeen Playground Areas
- Disc Golf Course
- Outdoor Personal Training Area
- Dog Park

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Structures, plants, and the natural features may not be removed, damaged or defaced.
- No littering or dumping. Picnic areas must be clean and orderly after use.
- Fires may be built in grills or fireplaces only, must be attended at all times and extinguished prior to leaving.
- Dogs and cats must be leashed. Please be responsible and clean up after your pet.
- Skateboards, roller blades, and bicycles are prohibited on basketball and tennis courts.
- Motor vehicles must remain on designated roads and parking lots. No driving or parking on the grass and/or walking paths. No parking permitted in the Service/Office driveway. Dirt bikes, mini-bikes, and ATV's are prohibited in all parks.
- Any alcohol or illegal substance is prohibited.
- Swimming, boating, and ice skating are prohibited. Sledding is considered an "at your own risk" activity.
- Fireworks and explosives, including aerial rockets, are prohibited.
- No person may hunt, trap, or endanger animals in any way. All forms of archery are prohibited.
- Sales, solicitation or placement of any signs within the parks requires permission from the City Manager as specified in the special event application.
- Shelters, courts, and fields are available on a first-come basis unless previously reserved.
- Further restrictions may apply as set by the City and/or Parks and Recreation Superintendent.

Making A Reservation

Our park facilities are available to the public on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you're planning a group function, reserving a shelter for your event is highly recommended.

Shelter Reservation Fee:

Residents - \$10
Non-residents - \$25

Atherton Amphitheater Fee:

Residents - \$25
Non-residents - \$50

- Picnic shelters at the amphitheater are available year round. Online reservations begin annually on February 1.
- To reserve a facility go to ci.fairborn.oh.us and select the 'Reserve a Shelter' link. All reservations are processed through the website and are paid for online.
- Large functions that will be open to the public and/or include marketing efforts MUST be processed on a "Special Event" application through the Parks Office
- Restrooms, typically, open in April and close in October, dependent upon the weather.
