

Chapter 8 - Trash Collection Details

Collection Day

Waste Management will continue to service the City of Fairborn with residential trucks from our Fairborn Hauling District.

Routes and schedules will be maintained as they are today. And we will continue to make sure that service is complete each service day.

Holiday Schedule

Waste Management typically observes national holidays as shown below:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

In the event that a holiday falls on a weekday, refuse, recycling and yard waste collection service will be delayed one day after the recognized holiday during the holiday week. Notice of the service day change is found on wm.com and we encourage residents to use the website. Residents will receive phone or email notification of the service day change.

Acceptable Waste vs Unacceptable Waste

Waste Management will abide by the items listed in the bid specifications.

Missed Trash Procedure

In the event a missed pick-up occurs, residents of City of Fairborn should contact the Customer Care Center immediately via phone at 800 343 6047. Customer Care will report the incident to the hauling district to resolve the issue by scheduling the recovery pickup within 24 hours. The day after the recovery pickup is scheduled Customer Care will follow-up with resident to confirm service was performed.

96 Gallon Trash Cart Plan

Waste Management will work with the manufacture and the City upon award of the contract to create a time-line and information regarding cart delivery and how to properly use the carts.

Bulk Pickup Plan

Bulk wastes are picked up on the City's service day from the curb. Bulky wastes include old mattresses, box springs, tables, chairs, other old furniture, and old refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, etc. with all coolants removed! Place bulky wastes 3' from the curb on the evening prior to service day or no later than 7:00 a.m. on service day.

Acceptable Material vs Unacceptable Material

The following are materials that Waste Management of Ohio, Inc. will accept in the bulk pickup program.

Acceptable Items	Instructions for placing them out for pickup
Bed Frames/Box Springs/ Mattresses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mattress & Box Spring are considered 1 bulk item. Must be doubled wrapped in plastic with duct tape to ensure safety
Bicycles	
Cardboard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be flattened and bundled not exceeding 4x4 and not exceeding 50 lbs.
Carpet & Padding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 bundles equal 1 bulk item. Must be dry, rolled & tied with tape or string into 4ft sections no heavier than 50 lbs.
Furniture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be doubled wrapped in plastic with duct tape to ensure safety
Grills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gas grills must have propane tank removed prior to disposal
Push Lawn Mowers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be drained of all oil and or gas prior to disposal. We do not accept riding lawn mowers.
Paint Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paint must be solidified before we can collect. • Residents can use kitty litter, sand or sawdust to solidify wet paint. • Lid must be removed and placed in cart and can with solidified paint will need to place at curb for collection.
Storm Doors /Windows	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All glass must be broken out of doors and windows. Broken glass needs to be placed in a hard container or small box, taped and marked broken glass. • Large amounts may require an extra fee.
Swing Sets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be broken down, no poles over 6ft.

Any item not listed on the acceptable bulk item list must be confirmed acceptable prior to placing item out for pickup. You may call the customer service team to verify if an item is acceptable for pickup.
